DUMPSTERS
IF PLACED ON STREET

NEED APPROVAL OF [PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT](#)

Permission for placement of a dumpster on a public right-of-way is given by the Public Works Department (368-5800). Once permission is granted the following guidelines must be followed by the applicant:

1. The Dumpster is to be placed on the street only when you are actively doing demolition work.
 - A. The actual location approved for the roll-off container may be adjusted by Village personnel if it is determined that the originally approved location is blocking pedestrian access, creating a hazard to motorists or interferes in any way with normal operations within the right-of-way.
 - B. Individual roll-off containers must not remain on the street more than three working days.
 - C. If the roll-off containers are not moved and emptied every three (3) working days, this permit expires, and the containers must be removed immediately.
2. Two lighted folding type barricades are to be placed at each end of the container.
3. The public sidewalk is not to be obstructed while the dumpster is in place. Care must be used to make sure that pedestrian traffic can safely use the public sidewalks.
4. During severe winter weather, it may become necessary to entirely remove the roll-off container from the street in order that the Village may complete snow clearing operations. You will be advised if this is necessary.
5. You are expected to keep the area in a neat, clean and orderly condition. You are responsible for any and all claims for injury or damage resulting from the authorization to utilize the public right-of-way.
6. You must provide us with an acceptable certificate of insurance.
7. Public Works will require the following information from each applicant:
 - A. Address of work
 - B. Name of contractor/applicant
 - C. Address of contractor
 - D. Contractor's phone number
 - E. 24-hour phone number for contractor and contact person
8. You are to **immediately** notify Public Works Department of any accident or claim arising out of the authorization to place this dumpster in the public right-of-way.
