The Numbers Add Up

2 Nearly 2 cents on every dollar residents spend in Arlington Heights are returned to the Village. This enhances the quality of life in our community.

40 The top 40 businesses in Arlington Heights generate over \$8.0 million in sales tax revenue to the Village. Some of these businesses include Roto Lincoln Mercury, Arlington Heights Ford, Bill Sullivan Pontiac, Target, Best Buy, Lowe's, Jewel, Kohl's, Mitsuwa, Trader Joe's, Valli Produce, Dominick's, Guitar Center, Garden Fresh Market, Dick's Sporting Goods, Marshalls, Portillo's, Walgreens, Arlington Race Course, Ashley Furniture, Walter E. Smithe Furniture, and Harlem Furniture.

100 Every \$100 spent in Arlington Heights the Village residents receive \$2.00 in sales tax revenue. Keep sales tax dollars in Arlington Heights and don't export your sales tax dollars to other communities.

\$100 grocery store purchase = \$1.00 in sales tax revenue
\$100 electronics purchase = \$2.00 in sales tax revenue

0 Village residents lose money when they shop outside Arlington Heights or purchase items over the internet. A \$100 purchase in another community or over the internet = \$0 in sales tax revenue to Village residents.

1,000 \$1,000 spent in Arlington Heights Village residents receive \$20.00 in sales tax revenue.
\$1,000 spent in Arlington Heights = \$20.00 in sales tax revenue to Village residents.
\$1,000 computer purchase in Arlington Heights = \$20.00 in sales tax revenue to Village residents.
