The Village of Arlington Heights and the Arlington Heights Memorial Library are planning to host a community meeting to obtain input on the potential property transfer and re-use of the former Teen Center, 112 N. Belmont Avenue property. The Village owns the property and no longer has a need or purpose for the property.

This property, having been improved using Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in excess of \$25,000, is subject to federal regulation 24 CFR 570.505 Use of Real Property.

In compliance with 24 CFR 570.505 Use of Real Property, the Village of Arlington Heights hereby gives notice to the citizens of the Village of Arlington Heights that the Village intends to change the use of this property to one which may or may not meet a national objective of the CDBG program and which may result in the disposition of the property.

The public is invited to comment on the proposed change in use and beneficiaries of the property, including the possible disposition of the property by the Village.
