**INFORMATIONAL CONTENT ONLY: FOR HOURLY RATE CUSTOMERS**

Dear Resident or Small Business Owner:

The Village of Arlington Heights is continuing our Green Electric Aggregation program. Following the passage of a March 2012 voter referendum, which authorized the Village to adopt aggregation programs, the Village has procured electric supply in bulk for residents and small businesses when viable. MC Squared Energy Services, LLC (mc<sup>2</sup>), was selected in a competitive bid process to serve the Village with electric supply and Renewable Energy Certificates. mc<sup>2</sup> will provide eligible residents and small businesses with an electric supply price equal to the ComEd rate for a 36-month term beginning with the December 2020 ComEd meter read cycle. Through this program, the Village will be designated an EPA Green Power Community at no added cost to residents or the Village.

**Your account will not be switched to mc<sup>2</sup>. You will remain a ComEd customer. This notice is informational only.** Your electric utility has informed us that you are currently a participant in the Residential Real Time Pricing (Rate RRTP) program. If you choose to participate in the Village's Green Electric Aggregation program, you must take action. You may enroll at [www.mc2energyservices.com/special](http://www.mc2energyservices.com/special) (enter promo code Arlington Heights) or call 833-748-0914, Monday through Friday, 8 am to 5 pm. **Savings, if any, will vary for previous ComEd Rate RRTP customers when switching to the Aggregation program depending on your usage patterns. In addition, you may be prevented from leaving the ComEd hourly supply program by the terms and conditions of ComEd's Rate RRTP plan. If you leave the ComEd hourly program, you will be precluded from joining the ComEd RATE RRTP for 12 months.**
