INFORMATIONAL CONTENT ONLY: FOR NET METERING CUSTOMERS

Dear Resident or Small Business Owner:

The Village of Arlington Heights is continuing our Green Electric Aggregation program. Following the passage of a March 2012 voter referendum, which authorized the Village to adopt aggregation programs, the Village has procured electric supply in bulk for residents and small businesses when viable. MC Squared Energy Services, LLC (mc²), was selected in a competitive bid process to serve the Village with electric supply and Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs). mc² will provide eligible residents and small businesses with an electric supply price equal to the ComEd rate for a 36-month term beginning with the December 2020 ComEd meter read cycle. Through this program, the Village will be designated an EPA Green Power Community at no added cost to residents or the Village.

Your account will not be switched. You will remain with your current supplier. This notice is informational only. Your electric utility has informed us that you are a participant in a net metering program through either ComEd or a retail electric supplier. **Because you are a net metering customer, your account will not be switched to mc².** If your net metering contract is with the Village's previous electric aggregation program supplier, please understand that you may forfeit any excess kWh credits with that supplier at the December 2020 term expiration. Your account will be switched back to ComEd at that time, and you would be advised to re-apply for a new net metering contract with ComEd. You may visit www.ComEd.com to do so.

You may purchase electric supply from other Retail Electricity Suppliers or ComEd. For a complete list of your options, visit pluginillinois.org. You may request a list of all supply options available in a format allowing comparison of price and product from the Illinois Power Agency free of charge at illinois.gov/ipa/Pages/Feedback_Form.aspx.
